- 1. This posting includes Laboratory Medicine (Para-clinical) & Infectious Diseases.
- 2. This includes maternity training and family welfare (including Family Planning).
- 3. This posting includes Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

#### Note:

1. The clinical postings will be 15 hours per week (3 hrs. per day from Monday to Friday). Out of 15 hours, 3 hrs. per week will be allotted to training in clinical and procedural skills lab for SGD/DOAP/Role Play.

2. Clinical posting shall focus on history taking, physical examination, assessment of change in clinical status, communication and patient education.

**3**. Learner doctor method of learning will be started on day 4 of posting. However Clinical Departments are free to choose the day. The team of 16 students in each batch (Further subdivided into two sub batches, each sub batch has 8 students) will be posted with a patient from admission till discharge everyday till 6 PM. Each team will be supervised by an assigned faculty for the learner doctor method.

# \* Learner Doctor Method

### Aims & Objectives:

- 01. The learner becomes a part of the healthcare team.
- 02. Although the learner shall not be given independent charge of the patient, he/she shall be assigned patients.
- 03. Learner shall remain with the admission unit until 6 pm (Except the designated class hours)
- 04. Learner shall also be a part of the rounds at least on one other day other than admission.
- 05. Learner shall discuss the ethical and other humanitarian issues during the rounds.
- 06. Learner shall follow the patient's progress until discharge.
- 07. Learner shall participate in procedures for the assigned patients under supervision
- 08. Learner shall document observations in the logbook.

## **Focus of the Doctor Learner Method**

Phase I	Introduction to hospital environment, early clinical exposure, understanding perspectives of illness.
Phase II	History taking, physical examination, assessment of charge in clinical status, communication and patient education.
Phase III Part I	All of the above and choice of investigations, basic procedures and continuity of care.
Part III Part II	All of the above and decision making, management and outcomes.

Assessment: Logbook shall be assessed by a designated faculty for its completeness, timely submission, quality of the report on the assigned patient and the outpatients. Completed logbooks shall form eligibility criteria to appear in the final examination of the subject.
